

RULES OF COMPTON HARRIERS RUNNING CLUB

1 Name and address

The club is called COMPTON HARRIERS RUNNING CLUB.
It is based at the Institute for Animal Health (IAH), Compton, Berkshire.

2 Affiliation

The club is currently affiliated to the following organisations:

- IAH Compton Recreation Association.
- England Athletics.
- South of England Athletic Association (SEAA).
- Berkshire County Athletic Association (BCAA).

3 Purpose

The purpose of the club is to promote running as a social event, enabling members to improve their own standards in a friendly and supportive environment.

4 The Committee

The management of the club is vested in the Committee, which will consist of five officers - Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, and Events Secretary - and up to 3 more elected members.

The Committee will be elected at the Annual General Meeting and will be re-elected each year.

No member may hold more than two official posts.

No meeting of the Committee will be in quorum unless five members, including at least three officers, are present.

The Committee has the power to fill any vacancy that may arise between AGMs.

5 Membership

Any member of the Club must be either a FULL or ASSOCIATE member of the IAH Compton Recreation Association.

The Committee reserves the right to deny renewal of membership to any individual.

6 New Members

New members are required to complete and sign the appropriate application form.

The Committee reserves the right to refuse membership to any individual.

7 Subscriptions

Members must pay an annual subscription fee to the club and an annual subscription fee to IAH Compton Recreation Association.

Subscription fees will become due on the 1st January each year.

The annual club subscription fee will be reviewed every year at the AGM.

8 Annual General Meeting

The Annual General Meeting will take place on a convenient date during the last two weeks of November or the first 2 weeks of December to receive the Committee's reports and financial statement, to elect officers and Committee and to deal with any other matter specified on the agenda.

The Chairperson or Secretary must give every member 21 days notice of the meeting.

Notice of any business to be placed on the agenda must be given in writing to the Chairperson or Secretary at least 14 days prior to the meeting.

9 Extraordinary General Meeting

An Extraordinary General Meeting must be called by the Secretary within 14 days of the receipt of a requisition in writing signed by at least five members of the club, stating the business to be brought before such a meeting.

10 Alteration of Rules

No alteration or addition may be made to the rules except by an Annual General Meeting or an Extraordinary General Meeting called for the purpose.
